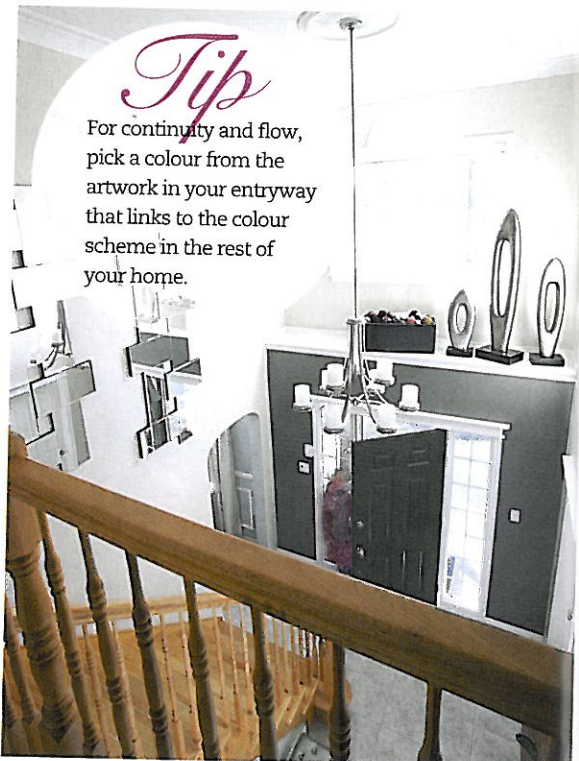


Make an entrance

Tip

For continuity and flow, pick a colour from the artwork in your entryway that links to the colour scheme in the rest of your home.

SLEEK AND MODERN

In this entryway, Wendy Monaghan updated a traditional wood staircase with modern elements that lend sparkle and drama to the space. "I created a focal point with three paintings by Halifax artist Daniel Peck," says Monaghan, noting that their orange tones create flow with the rest of the home's décor. She brought glamour to the space with the metallic finish of the bench, the sparkly patina of the vase and the mirrors on the staircase that refract light in the area. "It all carries the sparkle in subtle ways in the space to keep the modern feeling," she says.
