Southern Charm

Eye-catching antiques and layers of pattern elevate a breezy sunroom.

Over the years, antiques expert Furlow Gatewood has captured the interest of the design community, beautifully restoring a series of homes in small-town Georgia and filling them with a blend of rare objects, humble treasures and unusual finds. The back porch of the Cuthbert House, a mid-19th-century home on Furlow's family compound, is a fine example, with its mix of laid-back wicker, vintage ikat textiles and elegant china vases. Here, unique accents also tell a story about Furlow himself: an architectural model nods to his enduring love of Gothic style, and a graphic Indian dhurrie references past antique hunts across the globe. White louvered shutters and latticework are an ideal backdrop for these striking items — and a cooling respite from the Southern sun — while potted greenery enhances the room's indoor-outdoor ethos. Taken in together, it's a space that feels both handsome and inviting, revealing the expert eye of a collector who, at 92 years of age, is still searching for beautiful things.
